This approach will also pay rich dividends and our students will be able to represent the school and win accolades in many prestigious inter-school quiz competitions. The **'Lakshya Quiz Masters completion will also** build a quizzing culture among our students right from Grades 1 to 8 and give a new platform that would help them learn and nurture their passion for quizzing and current affairs. Your interest and cooperation in this collaborative quest for knowledge will be highly appreciated.

Here are a few guidelines for a better understanding and smooth functioning of the quizzing process.

1) The Quiz pots will be held in five categories.

Groups	Grades	Section
Group I	Grades I & II	Primary
Group II	Grades III & IV	Primary
Group III	Grades V & VI	Jr. Middle
Group IV	Grades VII & VIII	Sr. Middle

2) Questions will be given from the GK Text book for grade 1-VIII. A written quiz will be held by the end of each month which will include current affairs and certain other questions in addition to the questions that are given to the children. The test papers will include the questions given in the earlier papers too. All students from grade 1 to grade VIII will get an opportunity to participate in this competition.

Every child is expected to write all the five tests. The top 8 (based on the average) will qualify for the final round. The grand finale on stage will have a knock out round which will ultimately reduce the number of participants to four who will eventually battle it out to be crowned as the 'Quiz Champion'. Commendation certificates will be distributed to those who reach the last test in January. A student who

is absent for any round will be at a disadvantage, as the average will still be calculated out of five. An exception to this clause will be the students who seek admission in the month of July.

Let us endeavour together to motivate our wards to know the world around us and thus pave the way for a better future.
